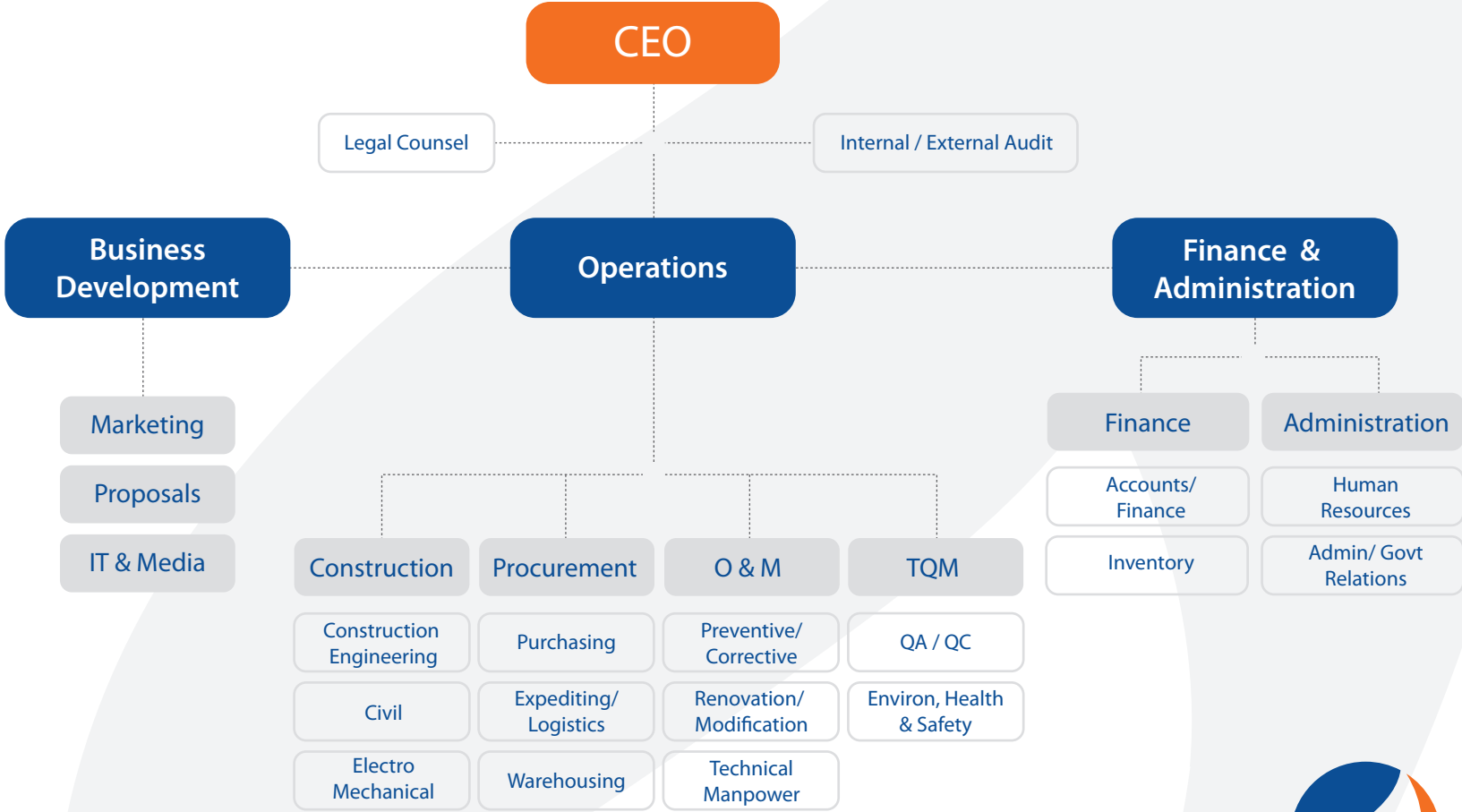

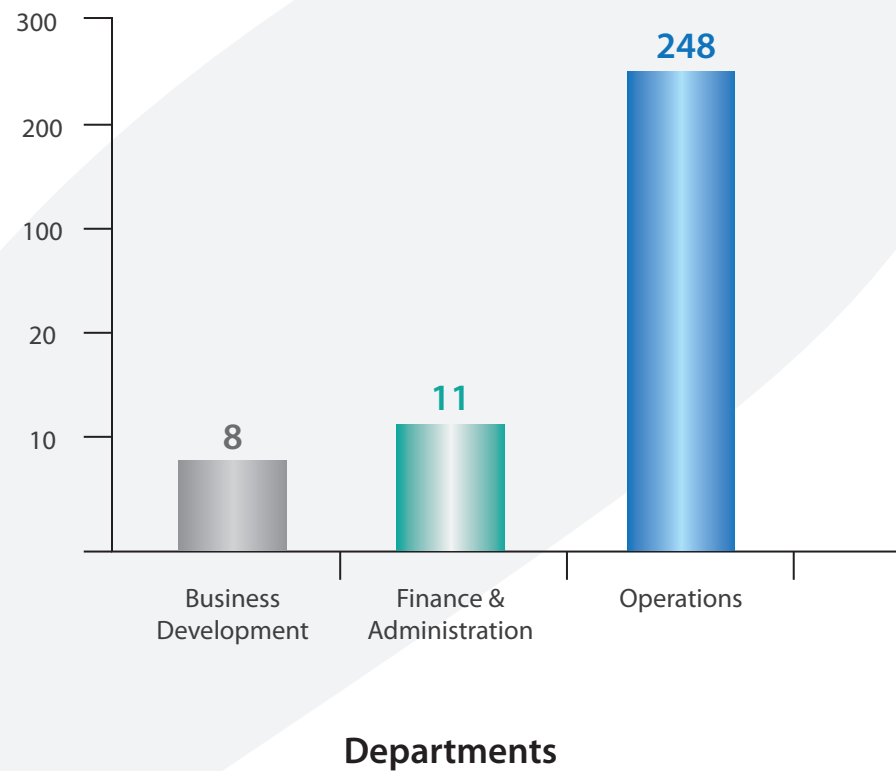


# Organization Chart
